Survey for Performance Evaluation of Kochi Water Metro


The department in association with KSCSTE NATPAC has conducted a questionnaire survey as part of the project "Performance Evaluation of Kochi Water Metro" on South Chittoor – High Court Stretch on 7th and 8th March 2022. 23 UG and PG students along with 4 staff have conducted the survey and completed successfully. Around 730 people were interviewed to collect socio demographic characteristics and trip characteristics. It provided students an exposure to the practical applicability of questionnaire surveys in traffic and transportation engineering.





MAPATHON

Department of Civil engineering, TIST has successfully completed mapping of various entities located in Piravom municipality as part of Mapathon project and got the certification from Kerala State IT mission. Mapathon project is an initiative by Kerala State IT Mission in order to conduct mapping of various entities located in municipalities of all districts of the state. This is accomplished using open street mapping software and OSM GPS tracker in android applications.4 faculty members and 19 students have undergone training in Open Street Mapping Platform by the mapping experts from Kerala State IT Mission. The project was completed during the period September to December 2021. This mapping data will be useful for various government agencies for emergency evacuations during disasters which is in view of recent flood situations faced by the state.
