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ABOUT US

Toc H is an international organization with its headquarters in the UK. Toc H International was founded by Rev. Tubby Clayton, an army chaplain, in a tall white house in Poperinge, Belgium, during the First World War. Talbot House, as the house was called - or Toc H in signaller's code - provided a haven of rest and refuge for wounded and sick soldiers. With the restoration of peace in 1918, Toc H became a worldwide movement offering solace and succor and provided a forum for community activity. From that time, through the Second World War, to this day, Toc H has continued to exercise a beneficent influence, building better communities, calming hostilities and effecting a reconciliation, and it has become a worldwide family with members and staff drawn from different countries, cultures and linguistic groups, and diverse ethnic backgrounds.

The Cochin branch of Toc H was started in the early seventies. In the beginning, it focused on rehabilitating the marginalized and other backward social classes. Later, realizing the need for quality education in Kochi, Toc H started the Toc H Public School Society in the year 1978. Toc H Institute of Science and Technology (TIST) which started in the year 2002, as a silver jubilee project of the Toc H Public School Society and is the synonym for excellence in education. Crowned with a reputation that has been painstakingly achieved over 25 years of successful existence, TIST is an inevitable extension of the gorgeous Toc H ethos, that keeps abreast of the emerging technologies and imparts technical education with a global perspective. The MBA Programme was incepted in the year 2008 with the aim of transforming students into competent future managers for a brighter tomorrow. And till date has made a mark in the industry with its competent managers.

Toc H Public School Society, Kochi, presently consists of 11 service-minded people. 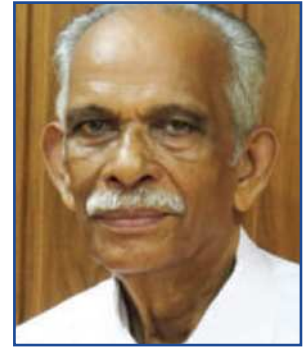

International Student Exchange Programme - UoK

A Memorandum of Understanding for academic, scientific, and cultural cooperation between the University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka, and the Toc H Institute of Science and Technology, Kerala, which was initially signed in 2014, was reviewed in 2023 for a period of five years. The fruitful association has resulted in seven student exchange programmes, two jointly organised international seminars, and co-hosting the first ever Indo-Sri Lankan research collaboration (ICBI 2018) at TIST campus. The event witnessed the participation of international delegates from countries like New Zealand, China, Sri Lanka, and Pakistan

De'Novo- The International Management Fest

The annual management fest, De' Novo, which was launched in 2010, provides a platform for national and international B-school students to showcase their talents. De' Novo has gradually evolved in terms of introducing innovative, creative, and challenging games, with an average participation of 400 students from across the country and abroad. This flagship event is wholly managed and executed by our students, giving them hands-on experience in organising an event of this magnitude. This year's title was won by the Christ University Bangalore for the Management Fest held in November 2023.

Grand Onam Trade Fair

The Department of Management Studies, to encourage entrepreneurial skills among the management students, organises a two-week-long Onam Trade Fair during the Onam Festival every year. This year's Grand Onam trade fair had different stalls like textiles, bakeries, a traditional food stall, Thattukada, a juice and smoothie stall, bags and footwear, recycled products, etc. In collaboration with Khadi Gramudodyog, and Hantex, stalls were also set up for displaying Khadi sarees, dresses, cosmetics, etc. The proceeds from this fair will be used to fund De Novo.

Industry Connect

This programme is designed to help the students to explore career choices and gain practical knowledge and skills. The internship offers students a period of practical knowledge and skills. The internship offers students a period of practical experience in the industry relating to their field of study. The experience is valuable to students as a means of allowing them to experience how their studies are applied in the real business world. The department provides opportunity to students for on the job trainings with Big Bazaar, More retail and Max Fashion every year.

Department's Extension Activities

The department has keenly undertaken many initiatives in order to inculcate our students with ethical values and empathy towards the society. The department organized team building and leadership development programmes for UG students in neighboring colleges. Similar training programmes were also organized by the students Government Girls UP School, Ernakulam to develop leadership skills among the young students. As a part of social outreach, students conducted surveys on behalf of Plan@Earth an NGO which works for sustainable waste management for project on waste management and recycling done in collaboration with Aluva municipality. The students also staged a street play to spread awareness among the residents of Aluva Municipality on the importance of sustainable waste management.

"Earn While You Learn,"

As a part of the department's entrepreneurial initiative, "Earn While You Learn," the MBA students are given opportunities to earn while organising various events on campus. This year, the students conducted a 3-day "Melon fest" in April 2022 and a 2-day "Cake fest" in December 2022. The proceeds from this event were donated to the De'Novo Fund.

"Talbot Talk"

Talbot House, the source of the name Toc H, was formerly a "every man's club" where men of all ranks came together to unwind, recharge, and exchange stories and ideas. Following in the footsteps of Toc H, the MBA department hosts the Talbot Talk series, a forum where alumni and industry professionals share their experiences with students. This series has featured notable speakers like Ms. Geethu Anna Rajan a SAP Specialist, Dr. Preeja Raman an entrepreneur who runs "Hug a Plant" both being our proud alumni and Mr. Aravind Warriar, HR Director @Rapid value from the industry for the consecutive three editions of Talbot Talk.



Toc H MBA became the first institute in Kerala to partner with Veleuciliste U Pozegi, Croatia, under the prestigious Erasmus + Mobility programme. Erasmus stands for European Community Action Scheme for the Mobility of University Students, established in 1987. Erasmus+ is a government-run programme by the European Union and is managed by agencies in each EU member country. The programme focuses on four different areas: education, training, youth, and sports, to improve skills and employability. To formalise the partnership, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed involving Veleuciliste U Pozegi, Croatia, and Toc H Institute of Science and Technology under the prestigious ERASMUS + exchange programme in 2018. This MOU offers an exchange of faculty and students between these two institutions. Under this agreement, six faculty members have represented India for the Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility for Academic Staff.

Admission Process

Students will be eligible for admission only if they have a valid score in any of the following entrance exam.

- ⇒ CAT- Conducted by IIM
- ⇒ CMAT - Conducted by NTA
- ⇒ KMAT – Conducted by Admission Supervisory Committee – Kerala

The admission process followed is as per the KTU regulations & Admission Supervisory Committee Kerala. The rank list is prepared on the basis of marks scored in Entrance Examination, Group Discussion and interview. The weightage of marks are as follows

- ⇒ Written Test (CAT/CMAT/KMAT) – 80%
- ⇒ Group Discussion – 10%
- ⇒ Interview – 10%

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates with minimum 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying graduation level degree course are eligible to apply.

It is mandatory that students seeking admission to the MBA programme should have the minimum qualifying cut off marks – (15% for general category, 10% for SEBC and 7.5% for SC/ST) in KMAT, CAT, and CMAT examinations.

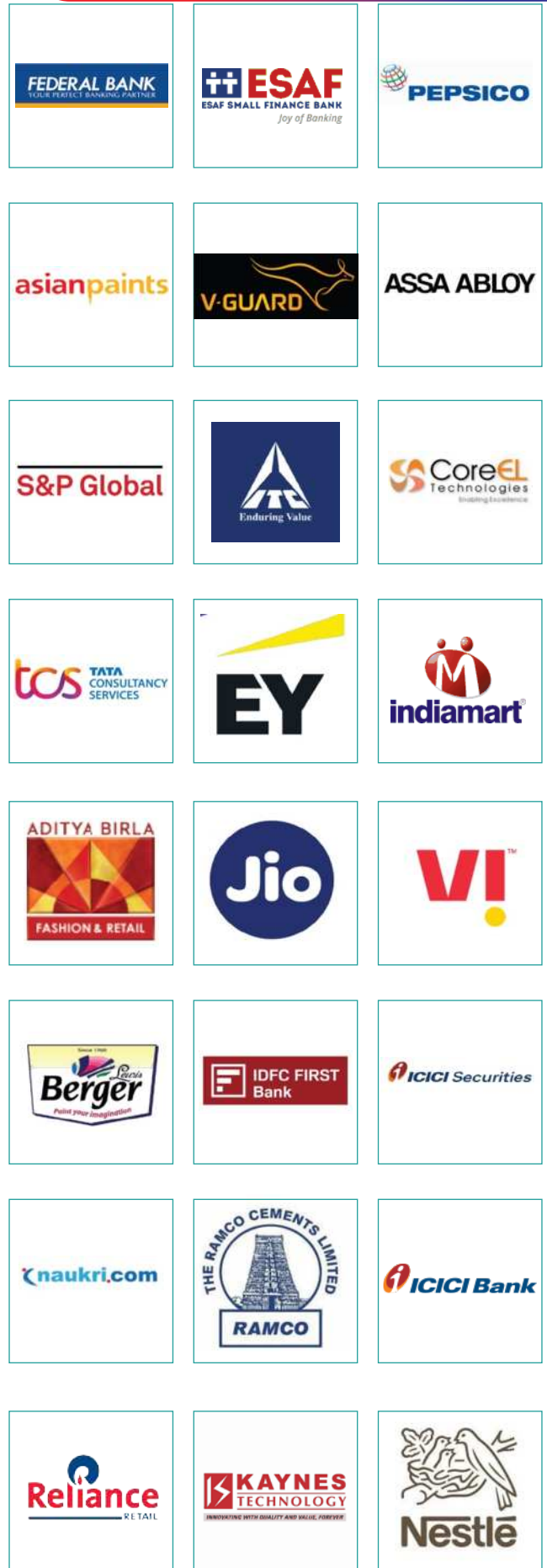

Refund Policy

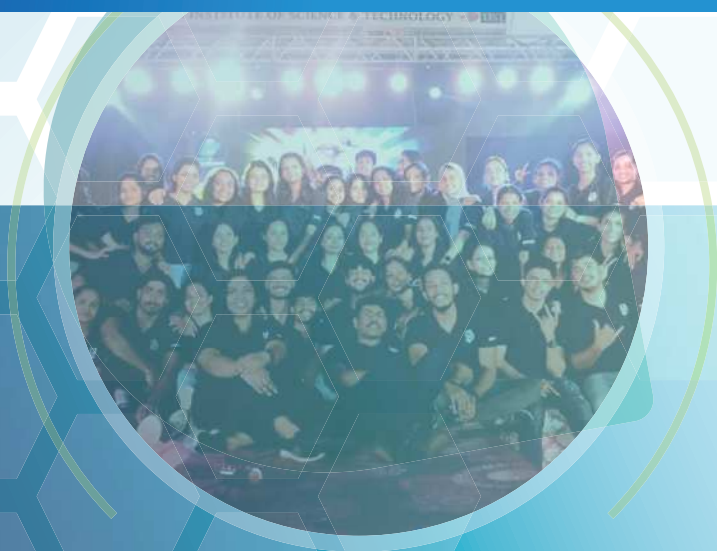
