Students Satisfaction Survey on curriculum and teaching learning process has been used towards the improvement in the quality of course delivery as well as student learning processes. For the academic year, student feedback is sought from 305 students about the curriculum and teaching-learning process.

Feedback Analysis Report

Most of the students were satisfied with the various aspects of the teaching like coverage of syllabus, preparation for classes, their communication skill, approach to teaching, internal evaluation process, assignments, internship, student exchange, field visit, mentoring, opportunities to learn and grow.

Over 47% of students express satisfaction in the use of ICT tools.

For curriculum delivery Revised Bloom's Taxonomy is strictly enforced in the institute. Teachers inform well in advance about expected competencies, course outcomes & programme outcomes. 80% of students have expressed satisfaction in this area.

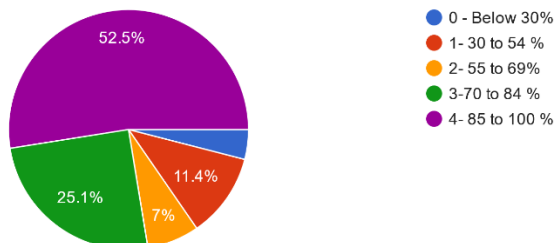

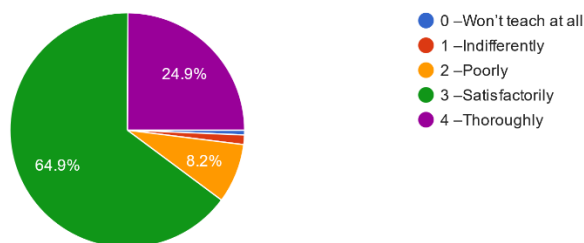
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class (AY 2023-24)?

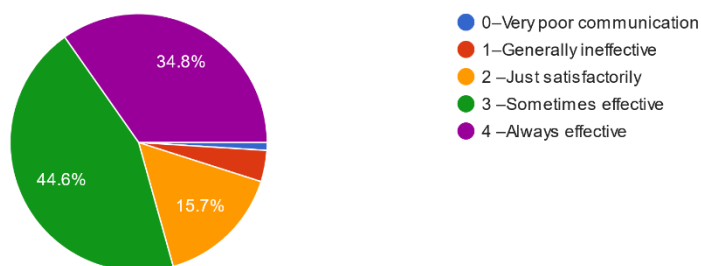
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes (AY 2023-24)?

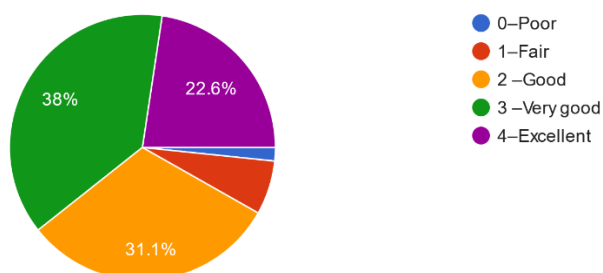
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

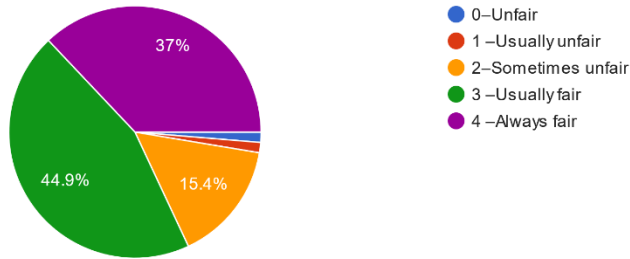
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

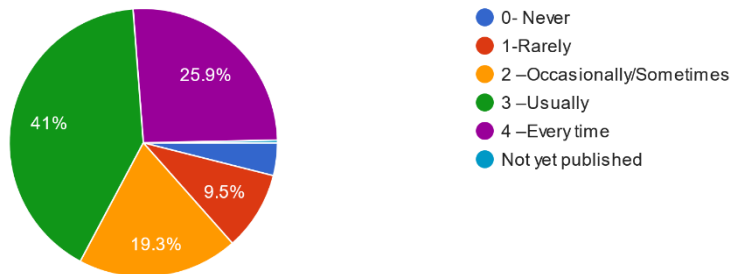
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers (AY 2023-24)

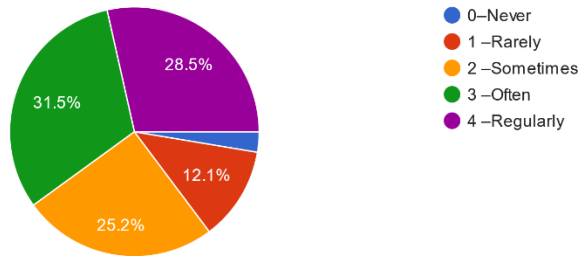
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you (AY 2023-24)?

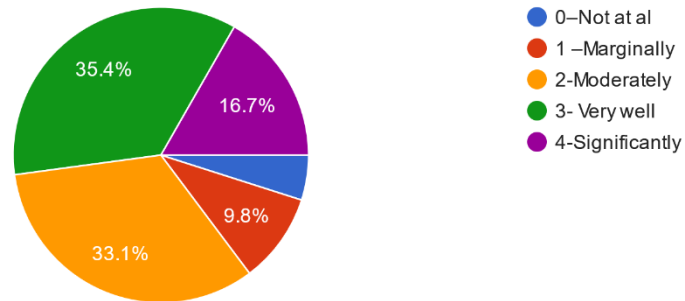
7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students

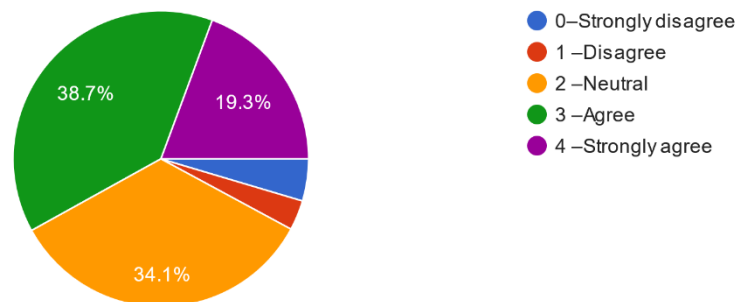
8.The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

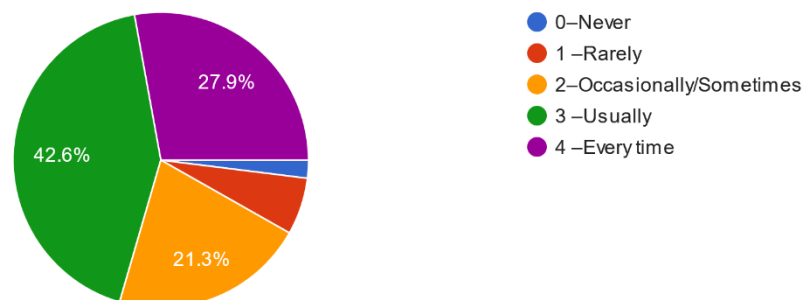
9.The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

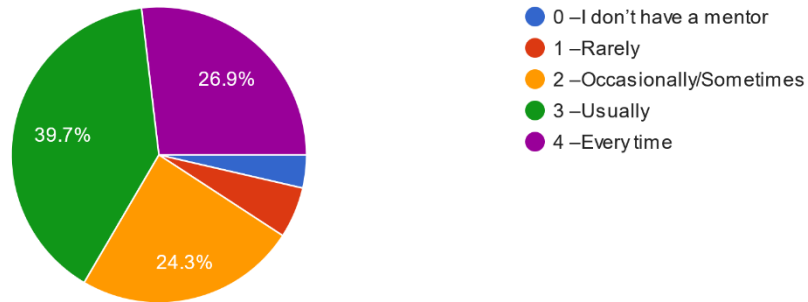
10.Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

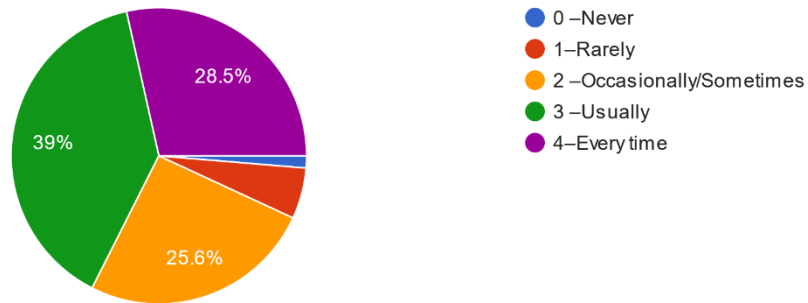
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

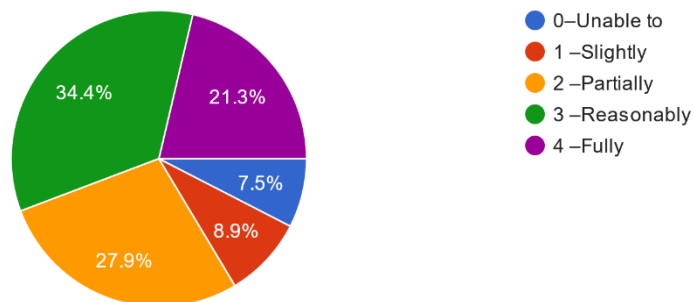
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

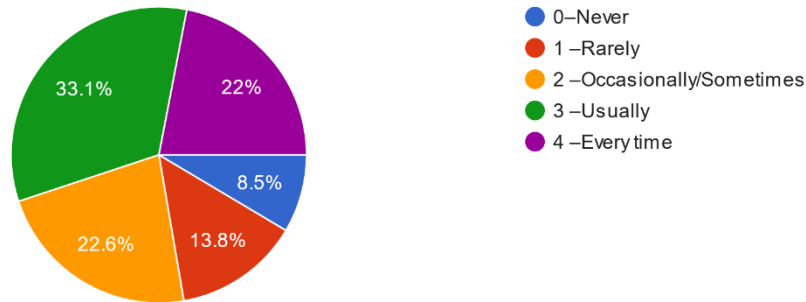
13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

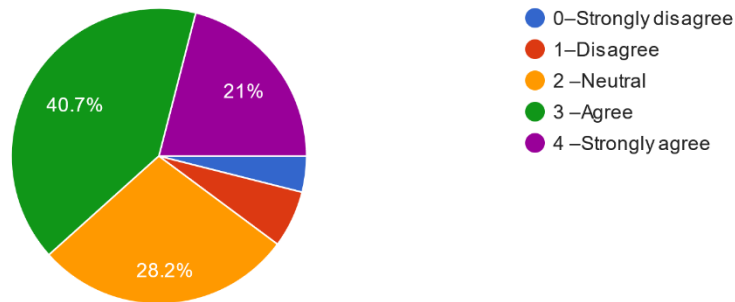
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

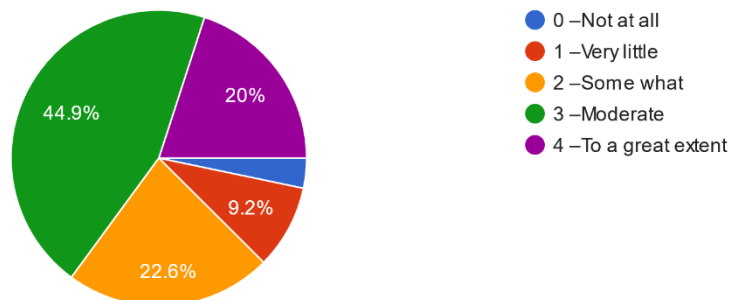
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process

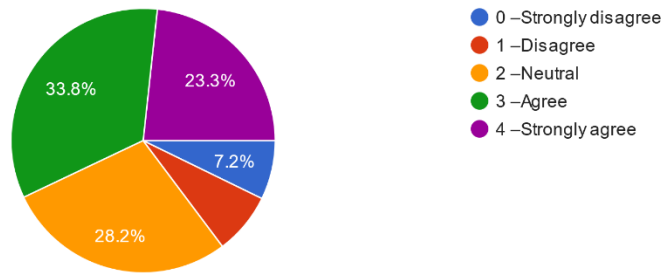
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participate learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

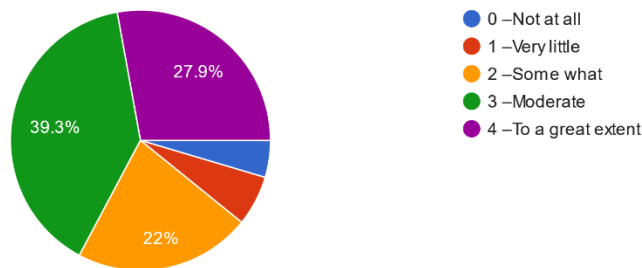
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

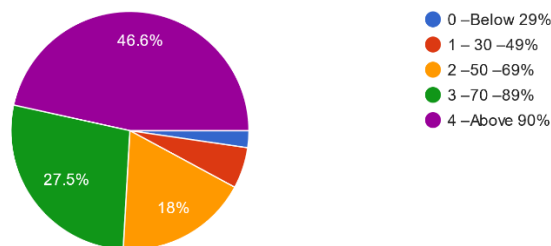
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work
